Puppets of Praise: A new season of Puppets of Praise will begin soon. This year we are going to try something new! Practices will be for 4 weeks prior to a performance. It is our hope with this shorter time commitment, we will get more people interested in this ministry. Anyone third grade and up is invited to participate – that means adults too! And a reminder to our youth that POP counts towards silver cord hours!

Our first performance will be Journey with Jesus. Saturday morning, October 21st at First Christian Church. This is a retreat for adults with disabilities and POP has provided the entertainment for many years. It is a highlight for those attending and a fun event for our puppeteers too! We need a minimum of 8 puppeteers for this event. This is a great opportunity for families to do something together. Practices will be Sunday evenings from 6 to 7 PM on the third floor of the LOFT - September 24, October 1, 8, and 15.

Our second performance will be Thursday, December 8th for Living Windows. This is another fun event where we showcase our puppet ministry in the front windows of the LOFT. Practices will be November 5, 12, 19 and December 3 (we will skip Thanksgiving weekend). This requires two teams – a minimum of 16 people.

We will also need a few people to be the stage crew – to set up and tear down our puppet staging. No puppeteering need for this!

Please prayerfully think about how you can participate in this unique ministry here at First UMC. There will be a sign-up sheet in the back of the sanctuary or you can let Dane or Melanie Sullivan know you are interested.

The third Sunday of each month is designated as Quiet Ministry Sunday. The September Quiet Ministry is the Community Action Food Pantry which serves the needs of Burlington's hungry. Your regular church donation does not go to support this ministry; it goes to pay the church's bills.

Only your intentional, designated gift goes to help this and the other Quiet Ministries. No one stands up to beg for your donation. It is up to you to decide if you want to feed the hungry and make this gift, designated in your memo or on your envelope as "Food Pantry." Your gift provides perishable food and food from the lowa Food Bank, and it is greatly appreciated. Thank you!

School supplies are being gathered for Ingathering kits from now through October 9! Empty plastic bags with the supply list attached are available on tables at the back of the sanctuary. When the bags are filled, you may deposit them in the school bus tubs at the back of the sanctuary or at the Loft office.
